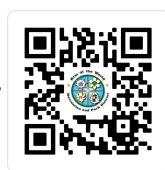

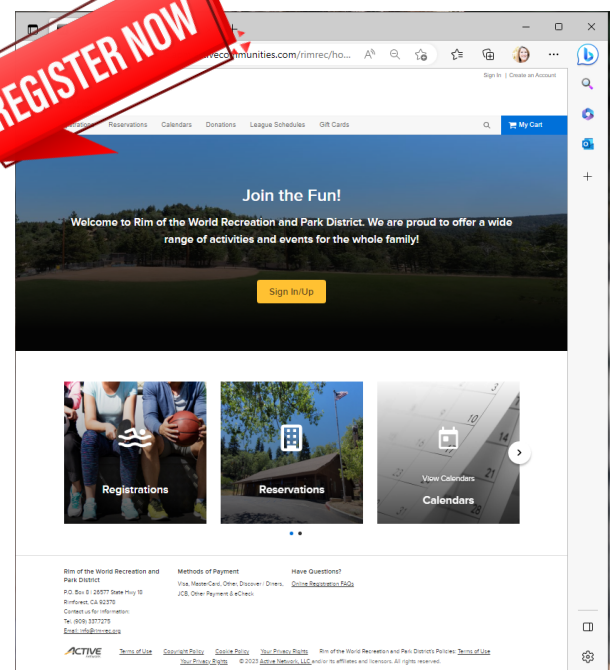

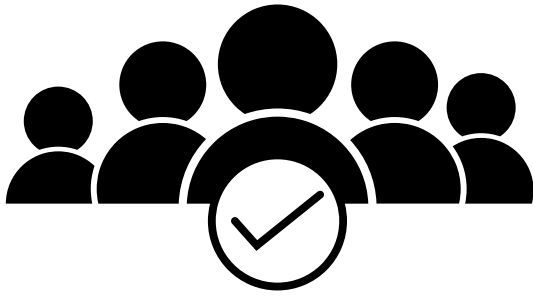

TRUSTEE AREA/DIVISION 2 BOARD MEMBER VACANCY

A vacancy on the Board of Directors of the Rim of the World Recreation and Park District for Division 2 occurred on January 31, 2024. Per Government Code §1780 this vacancy must be filled by appointment on or before March 31, 2024.

Requirements for this position are that the appointee must be a qualified State of California voter in the district residing and owning property in **trustee area/division 2** within the Rim of the World Recreation and Park District boundaries. **Visit the District Look-Up Tools – San Bernardino County Registrar of Voters (sbcounty.gov) that is posted on the Park District website www.rim-rec.org or call the Park District to find out what District you reside in, (909) 337-7275.**

To apply the Candidate's Statement of Qualifications, which shall include personal background information and reasons for seeking the vacant position, must be filed at the Rim of the World Recreation and Park District office, 26577 State Highway 18, Rim Forest, by 4:00 p.m. on March 15, 2024. Interviews will be conducted at the March Board Meeting on March 25, 2024. The meeting will be held at the District Office, 26577 State Hwy 18, Rimforest, CA 92378 and will begin at 6:00 PM.

Classes begin on Monday, August 28, 2023. Tuition is \$55.00 per class / per month, with Acrobatic level I being \$30 per month for the 20-min class. Tuition is based off of a 9-to-month dance school year model. The number of classes will vary from month to month. Tuition is a monthly fee whether there are 3-4 weeks in a month or 5-6 weeks. Tuition will not adjust. There are no refunds for missed classes or closures due to inclement weather. Drop-in fees are \$15.00 per class. Students paying monthly tuition fees, versus drop-in class fees, will be given priority enrollment in classes which become full. Class Level Placements are determined by class instructors. We will be closed Thanksgiving Break, Memorial Day, Labor Day, and Christmas Break. Additional closures may occur for Halloween and Veterans Day at the discretion of class instructors. There are many performance opportunities for our students throughout the season, including Halloween and Christmas showcases. The dance season will culminate with a June Recital - additional participation and class fees will apply.

THE WAY OF THE BOW (10-17 YRS.) | APR. 8TH - MAY 20TH

An 8 week course that is based on the book The Archer, by Paulo Coelho and adapted with MSP and USA Archery instruction resources. The teaching also provides skills such as goal setting and mindfulness which can be applied to other areas of life.
