- 8.2 **PUBLIC HEARING:** Pursuant to California Government Code Section 50077, this public hearing is to receive input and consider whether the Board should proceed with placing a parcel tax measure on the November 3, 2026 ballot. If approved by the voters, the proposed measure would increase the District's existing parcel tax from \$22 per parcel per year to \$37 per parcel per year. The proposed measure would also authorize an annual adjustment of up to one percent (1%) to partially offset inflation. **The Rim of the World Recreation and Park District's Board of Directors will hear comments from the public review and discuss taking appropriate action with respect to the following matters:**
