

Preparing for Cold Weather

While the onset of the cold season will vary, it's a good rule of thumb to begin the process of winterizing your home in early fall. The Park District Winterization includes turning off the water at our various outdoor bathrooms, parks, and ball field locations. This is done to prevent pipes from freezing and breaking.

We understand we may still have great weather to play outside, and the ball fields and other outdoor amenities can still be reserved, but the Park District will not turn the water on for these private events.

In an effort to keep our parks and facilities in the best condition possible, there are times when we need to close certain areas. The purpose of this is to prevent damage, allow the grounds a break, and/or to perform maintenance. All of these things are done with YOU in mind. Please pay attention to which areas are open and closed and please respect the signs we have posted.

We post all Public Notices or Announcements on the Park District website, www.rim-rec.org, and all emergency notifications, like Snow Days and/or other closures are highlighted on the top of our website in red.
